### GRADE 2

- 1 each Red, Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange and Purple **POLY** folders w/prongs and pockets
- 2 pr 5" pointed tip scissors

- Headphones for iPad to keep at school
- 1 container disinfectant wipes
- 1 roll paper towels
- 2 large boxes facial tissue
- 1 box gallon-sized zipper bags
- 1 box snack-sized zipper bags

### GRADE 3

- 1 1" 3-Ring Binder
- 1 pack 3-Ring Dividers 5-tab
- 2 pr 5" pointed tip scissors
- 1 pencil pouch, 3-hole w/grommets
- Earbuds to keep at school (must fit in pencil pouch)
- 1 container disinfectant wipes
- 2 large boxes facial tissue
- 1 box gallon-sized zipper bags

### GRADE 4

- 1 pencil pouch
- Headphones or earbuds to keep at school

- 1 2gb flash drive
- Earbuds to be kept at school
- 2 large boxes facial tissue
- Boys - 1 box sandwich-sized zipper bags
- Girls – 1 container disinfectant wipes

### GRADE 6

- 2 1.5" Clear cover Binder w/pockets
- 1 1" Clear cover Binder w/pockets
- 1 pencil case
- Earbuds to be kept at school
- 2 large boxes facial tissues
- Boys – 1 box gallon-sized zipper bags
- Boys – 1 roll paper towels
- Girls – 1 box sandwich-sized zipper bags
- Girls – 1 container disinfectant wipes

- Supplies can be brought in during the open house on August 15<sup>th</sup> from 1:00-3:00 p.m.
  - All pens, pencils, markers, crayons, glue, rulers, notebook paper, composition notebooks, and other items will be purchased with your school fees.
  - Grades 3-6 will be provided a planner.
